Jack Frederick Fors, 91, of Indianapolis, passed away December 1, 2018, the victim of a hit-and-run accident. Jack was born July 1, 1927 in Stevens Point, Wisconsin to the late Clarence and Loraine Morrissey Fors.

Jack graduated from P.J. Jacobs High School in Stevens Point and went into the Air Force at age 17, where he was trained as a cryptographer in intelligence. He was a gifted runner and ran for both the Air Force and in college and would have qualified for the Olympics; however, they were cancelled due to World War II. Jack was also in the band in high school and the military, playing saxophone, clarinet, bassoon and various other instruments. He attended the University of Wisconsin and South Dakota State University. Jack married Dolores Mae Hartl, May 24, 1952. He worked as a key account salesman for Shulton for 25 years, and won numerous awards there. He was well traveled and especially loved London and Hawaii. Jack was an extremely gifted artist and his family felt very fortunate to be the recipients of his beautiful paintings. He loved to build and fly RC model airplanes, had an amazing sense of humor, and was incredibly intelligent and very creative. He could figure out anything, gave wonderful advice and knew the answer to virtually any question. Jack was an avid sports fan and loved the Colts, Packers, and Pacers, even traveling with his daughter to the playoffs in New York City. He was a longtime member of Holy Spirit Catholic Church. His loss will leave a deep and lasting void in his family.
