September 25, 1918 - January 9, 2008

A. Dale Palmer, 89, of Indianapolis, passed away January 9, 2008. He was born September 25, 1918 in Terre Haute, Indiana to Ally and Sarah Ferguson Palmer, who have preceded him in death.
