Albert Lea Blake, MD, 94, of Indianapolis, IN, passed away January 30, 2018. He was born August 15, 1923 in Owensville, IN, to Benton Ola and Beatrice Argyle (Kreutzinger) Blake. He was a 1941 graduate of Mount Vernon High School, Indiana University Bloomington 1947, and Indiana University School of Medicine 1950, and a Veteran of the USAF Rank of Captain stationed at Itazuke Air Force Base.
