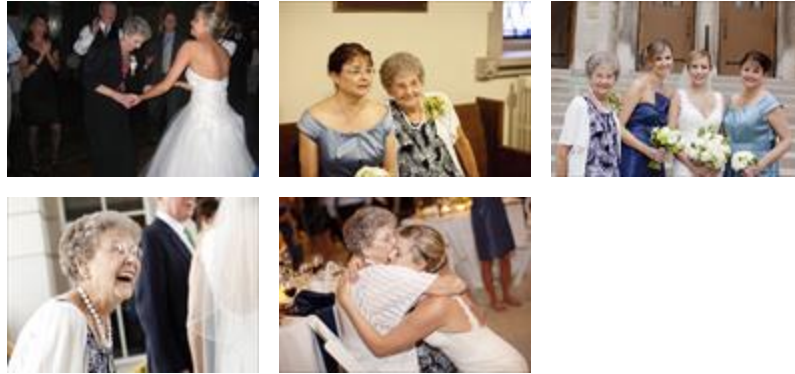
will miss their Gramma Jean.

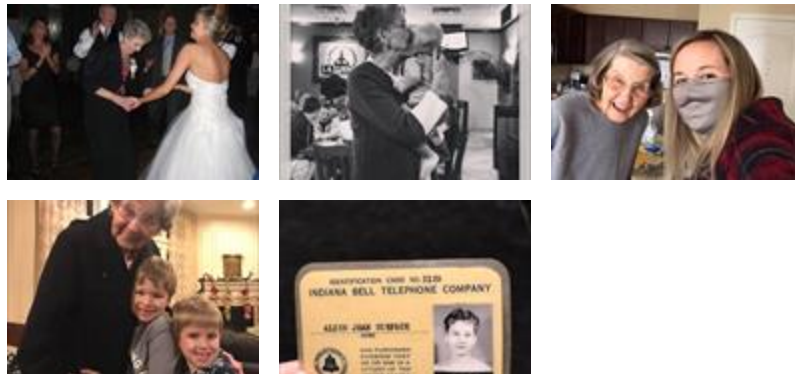
