He was the last living sibling of three brothers. Arnold was a WWII Marine Veteran and was fortunate to be chosen for the Indy Honor Flight in April 2014. Mr. Spivey was also a Lay Minister and was actively involved with the American Baptist Association, East Side Christian Center, Edna Martin Christian Center, Paragon Baptist Church, First Baptist Church of Plainfield and Woodland Baptist Church in Indianapolis.

Visitation will be Friday, December 19, 2014 from 11:00 a.m. until the time of service at 1:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel, 9606 E. Washington St. Entombment will follow at Lincoln Memory Gardens, Whitestown.
