Arthur O. Bredlau,

90, passed away January 13, 2019. He was born in Chicago, IL, October 21, 1928 of German immigrants, the third eldest of nine children. Art attended high school for two months before getting a job to help his family. He later received his Master's Certification. By the age of 16 he had been an ice delivery person, a caddy and a baker. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during the Korean War as a Sergeant. Art married Gloria Tazelaar, and for the first seven months of their marriage, they lived in a hayloft while building their first home. Together they had three children. Art mastered the Tool & Die trade, but loved the outdoors, and went into construction. He became an expert in precast and pre-stressed concrete. Art managed a precast manufacturing facility and a few years later became a field superintendent, managing many well known local projects such as the Pyramids and Market Square Arena.

Art and Gloria traveled extensively to all 50 states, Canada, 40 countries worldwide, as well as to the Arctic and Antarctic Circles. He was adept at topiary, mastered lapidary, was a gem collector, gardener, champion woodcarver, fisherman and handyman who could fix almost anything.

Art was preceded in death by his wife of 64 years, Gloria Bredlau; son, Scott Bredlau; and three brothers, Paul, Albert and Ted Bredlau.

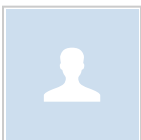
