Barbara graduated from Groves High School in Birmingham, MI. She received her Bachelor's Degree in Home Economics and Interior Design from Eastern Michigan University in 1972 and her Masters Degree in Guidance and Counseling in 1984. She worked for the American Red Cross for many years, retiring in 2006. Barbara served on the American Red Cross Disaster Team as a mental health specialist; a member of the Crisis Response Team of Greater Indianapolis; the Indianapolis School Crisis Team; Indiana Counseling Association; and was a 23 year volunteer for the American Red Cross teaching CPR, First Aid, Swimming, Basic Aid Training and Babysitting. She was a longtime member of Castleton United Methodist Church.

A Celebration of Life will be held Tuesday, September 14, 2021 from 4:30 p.m. until the Memorial Service at 6:30 p.m. at Castleton United Methodist Church, 7101 N. Shadeland Ave.

Barbara is survived by her loving sons, Jason Ball (Rebecca Czarmecki), and Bryan Ball; sister, Ann Wottring (Jim); a brother, G. Scott Bound; and six grandchildren.
