Betty Eloise Bigler, 94, of Fishers, passed away January 30, 2019. She was born August 16, 1924 in Tampa, Florida to the late Charlotte "Lottie" Howard Jennens and T.A. Jennens. Betty graduated from Rochester High School in 1942. She became a member of Tri Kappa in 1942, and served in Hobart, Knox and Crown Point. She married Charles R. Bigler, March 21, 1943 in Watertown, South Dakota. They returned to Indiana after the war and built a life. Chuck retired as Superintendent of Schools in 1987 and they built a home in Mesa, Arizona and lived there for 10 years. At the time of Chuck's death in February of 2001, they had been married for 57 years. Betty was married to Ben Severns of Athens, Indiana for six years.
