Brian Neil Conaway,

55, of Fishers, passed away October 15, 2024. He was born August 4, 1969 in Gary, Indiana to Thomas W. and Patricia A. Conaway. Brian was a graduate of East Gary Edison High School, Class of 1987. He had a double major in psychology and philosophy; then received his master's degree in psychology from Purdue University. He established Conaway Counseling and Consulting where he served as a behavior clinician to individuals throughout Indiana. As a licensed mental health counselor, he became a certified cognitive behavior therapist and clinically certified forensic counselor. He was a member of the American Psychological Association, Association for Psychological Science and the National Association for Forensic Counselors.

Brian personified music. Starting from his early years of being recognized for earning awards as a drummer for his high school band to his mastering of the electric guitar, his passion for music was seen and heard everywhere. If he was not playing the guitar, Brian would be found sharing his other joy of philosophy with his children and wife. He loved reading and philosophy, especially anything by Nietzsche, Foucault and Rorty to name a few. Brian was a proud Purdue alum. He enjoyed spending time with family and friends building long-lasting memories and traditions.

A memorial visitation will be Thursday, October 24, 2024 from 12:00 p.m. until the time of service at 2:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Fishers-Castleton Chapel, 9900 Allisonville Road, Fishers.

Brian is survived by his wife, Amy T. Conaway; daughters, Kagan Conaway and Kendall Conaway; son, Rylan Conaway; brother, Jason Conaway (Meilan Chen); and father, Tom Conaway. He was preceded in death by his mother, Patricia Conaway and brother, Michael Conaway.

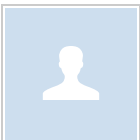
