



Bryce Roberts Baldwin

March 31, 1927 - May 17, 2013

Bryce Roberts Baldwin, 86, Indianapolis, passed away May 17, 2013. Bryce was born March 31, 1927 in New York City, NY and raised in Indianapolis where he was a graduate of Arsenal Technical High School. A veteran of WWII, he served in the U. S. Merchant Marine as a Midshipman, and graduated from the U S. Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, NY in 1948. Bryce joined the Allison Division of GMC for a 40 year career, as a test engineer, a design engineer, and later rising to the position of Chief Design Engineer for Large Engines. Bryce received several design patents from the U. S. Government, leaving a permanent legacy for Allison Engines. He attended the FAA Helicopter Accident Investigation School, and served as an expert witness in aviation product liability cases. He retired from Allison Gas Turbine Division in 1989 as Director of Reliability.

Bryce was a 55 year member of Holy Spirit Catholic Church.

Bryce's retirement years included his passion for golf, wintering at his second home in Cape Coral, FL, and enjoying life with his beloved wife of 65 years.

His proudest achievement was being a husband and a father.

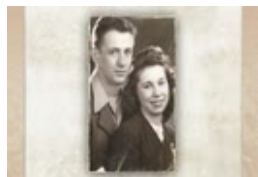
