C. Howard Jansen, Lifetime resident of Indianapolis, passed away February 22, 2008. He was born December 15, 1929 in Indianapolis to the late Charles H. and Helen J. Johnson Jansen. Mr. Jansen was a graduate of Shortridge High School, Class of 1947, and Indiana University, where he studied Marketing and Finance.
