Carl H. Happersberger, 89, passed away December 11, 2007 following a brief illness. Carl was born on April 6, 1918. A life-long resident of Indianapolis, Carl worked for VonDuprin, Inc. from 1936 until retiring in 1980. During that time, Carl rose to the position of Vice President. Carl was active in the hardware construction business and traveled extensively for VonDuprin throughout the United States and Canada.
