



## Carol Lou Dolen

April 25, 1930 - November 6, 2015

Carol Lou Dolen, 85, of Indianapolis, passed away November 6, 2015. She was born April 25, 1930 in Jasper, IN, to the late Cyril "Snap" and Lucille H. Krodel Giesler. Carol was a 1948 graduate of Jasper High School. She attended Indiana University and Ursuline College, Louisville, KY, where she received her Bachelor's Degree. She then began her career as one of the first female kindergarten teachers in Jasper, IN, where she met the love of her life, George W. Dolen, whom she married on July 12, 1956. He preceded her in death on October 28, 1998. After moving to Indianapolis, where she raised her four children she worked at the Indianapolis Racquet Club for over 25 years, retiring in 2003. Carol was a devoted wife, and a wonderful mother and grandmother. She was a member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church, Tri Kappa Sorority and Indian Lake Country Club.
