



## Carol Marie Sample

May 11, 1915 - February 21, 2008

Carol Marie Frye Sample, 92, passed away peacefully Thursday, February 21, 2008 at a nursing home in Indianapolis. She was born May 11, 1915 near Cambridge City. The family moved to Henry County in a horse-drawn cart and lived on a farm near Millville. They soon moved to Madison County, where the family eventually ran the Linwood Traction Station for several years.
