



## Carol Louise Thompson

October 3, 1937 - November 28, 2008

Carol Thompson, 71, of Indianapolis, passed away November 28, 2008 after a long brave battle with cancer. Carol was born October 3, 1937 in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. In 1959 she received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Psychology and a minor in Sociology from Dickenson College, located in Carlisle, PA. After graduation she moved to Washington D.C., and worked as a statistical assistant for the National Institute for Mental Health. In 1964, she transferred to the National Archives and Record Service. In the early 1970s, Carol was honored by being nominated Federal Woman of the Year by the Archivist of the United States. In 1979, Carol moved to Indianapolis, where she was employed by the Naval Avionics Center and the Emmet Bean Finance Center until she retired in 1991. Carol was a member of Linwood Christian Church, serving as a deaconess and in the church choir. She loved singing and harmonizing with the choir and chorale. Carol was a lifetime member of the VFW and the American Legion Auxiliaries. A memorial service will be held at Linwood Christian Church, 4424 E.
