Carter Calvin Slusher, 80, of Indianapolis, passed away on April 2, 2026. He was born on October 21, 1945 in Kansas City, Missouri to the late Lester Calvin and Marjorie Louise (Carter) Slusher. Carter was a proud Eagle Scout and honorably served his country in the U.S. Navy. He earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Missouri and went on to work as a chemist for Firestone Building Products for over 21 years.
