May 23, 1934 - July 5, 2021

Rev. Charles M. Benninghoff, 87, of Greenwood, passed away July 5, 2021. He was born May 23, 1934 in South Bend, IN to the late Donald D. and Silla Morton Benninghoff. Charles was a 1952 graduate of Fairmount High School. He married Janice L. Jones December 6, 1952. Charles evangelized from 1957 until 1960 when he and his wife planted and pastored a church in Cedar Rapids, Iowa for six years. He then assumed the pastorate of the United Pentecostal Church in Clinton, IN. for eight years before becoming the pastor of the United Pentecostal Church of Highland Village in Bloomington, IN for 27 years. He then assisted Pastor Ray Majors in Melville, LA until 2011. While pastoring he served the Indiana District of the UPCI as a Presbyter. Rev. Benninghoff has served the United Pentecostal Church, Int. as a minister for 65 years.
