



## Charles W. Duggan

October 9, 1921 - December 9, 2007

Charles W. Duggan, 86, Indianapolis, passed away December 9, 2007. He was born October 9, 1921 in Shelby Co., IN to Thomas and Mary Esther Ponsler Duggan, who have preceded him in death. He graduated from Arsenal Technical High School, Class of 1939 and served in the U. S. Army in WW II in the 8th Infantry Division. He was wounded in France and received a Purple Heart and Bronze Star and obtained the active duty rank of Captain. He then served in the Indiana Guard Reserve with the rank of Lt. Colonel. Charles married Betty L. Howell January 27, 1947. He worked for State Life Insurance as Personnel Director and Assistant Vice-President of Operations for 46 years, retiring in 1986.
