June 22, 1933 - April 4, 2018

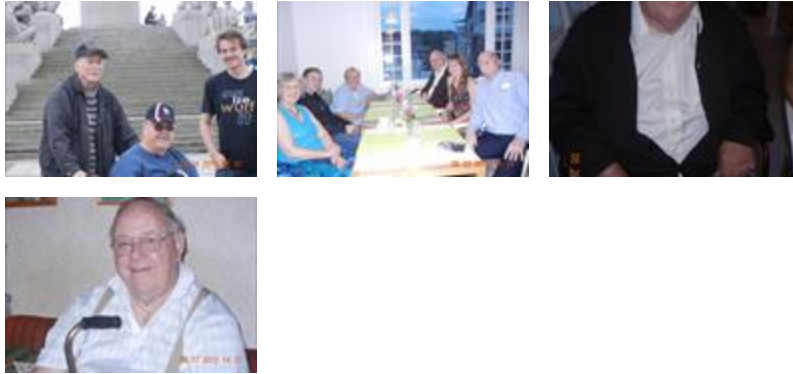
