Charles S. "Charlie" Kennedy, 67, of Indianapolis, died suddenly on October 13, 2017. He was born December 30, 1949 to the late Russell and Louise (Welch) Kennedy. Charlie had worked as a journalist, computer operator and programmer and a school bus driver. He belonged to All Souls Unitarian Church and participated in their Interfaith Hospitality Network project. He was active in the Libertarian Party and had served as a Little League Coach and Boy Scout Leader. He was also a member of Moose Lodge #1883 where he enjoyed karaoke. He was an avid bird watcher and music fan. He especially enjoyed travel and had been to all 50 states. Most recently he had traveled to Kentucky for the total eclipse.
