



Charles Franklin "Frank" Marshall

He was born November 10, 1924, in Clay, Kentucky to the late Paul Clay and Elizabeth Vernon Ramsey Marshall and moved to Indianapolis with his family in 1929. Frank graduated from Arsenal Tech High School in 1942 and attended Butler University. He served his country in the U.S. Army in the 42nd Rainbow Division during WWII, and married Frances L. Moore May 31, 1946. He was employed by Eastside Chevrolet for 16 years and then in the Quality Control Division of Allison Transmission for over 25 years, retiring in 1989. Frank was a member of Cumberland Christian Church, the Brookside Masonic Lodge #720 F. & A. M., Scottish Rite, Murat Shrine and was Charter Member of the Shrine Minicycle Club, Brookside Order of the Eastern Star #481, Amaranth Court #1, and White Shrine. Frank was also a member of the Rainbow Division Veterans Association, serving as the National President in 1971. He was awarded an Honorary Membership in the French Foreign Legion and was a member of the American Legion.
