



## Charles Robert "Bob" Smith

Charles R. "Bob" Smith,

83, of Greenfield, passed away April 28, 2023 after a brief illness. Bob was co-owner and operator of "Smitty's" Indianapolis Marine Co., manufacturer of custom boat canvas for 50 years, with his brother, Tim.

A lifelong bachelor, Bob enjoyed summers at his home around the pool, a popular gathering place for family and friends, and winters at his "Olde Naples" home in Florida, where he enjoyed relaxing on the Naples beach and pier chatting with friends old and new.

Bob enjoyed making people laugh and was notorious in Indy and Naples for cruising the streets in one of his classic autos accompanied by an array of stuffed animal characters, to the joy, laughter and dismay of all. Born on Christmas Day 1939, Bob often told folks "He and Jesus were born on the same day," followed by, "but not the same year".

Bob's favorite holiday however was Halloween, which he celebrated for days by decorating his vehicles with spiders, bats, rats and a variety of creepy creatures.

Bob was a graduate of Scecina Memorial High School's second graduating class and attended St. Francis de Sales and St. Philip Neri grade schools. He considered St. Philip Neri his home parish for life.

Bob was preceded in death by his father, Charles F. Smith; mother, Mary Jane Smith; brother, Ted Smith; brother-in-law, Roy Pellegrin; and niece, Brenda Pellegrin. He is survived by nine siblings, Tim (Pat) Smith, Barb Pellegrin, Pat
