Christine Laabs Schildbach, 67, of Fishers, passed away December 4, 2017. She was born August 19, 1950 in Milwaukee, WI to the late Arthur R. and Lorraine I. Laabs. Christine graduated from Oak Creek (WI) High School in 1968. She attended Northwestern University from 1968 through 1973. While in Evanston, Christine held the position of concertmaster in The Chicago Civic Orchestra. She also played in the second violin section of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra from 1973 until her retirement in 2006. Christine enjoyed gardening, teaching violin, reading and travel, especially to Yellowstone National Park. She was an avid supporter of Northwestern athletics.
