



Christopher Dale Wallace

October 7, 1974 - January 20, 2025

Christopher Dale Wallace, age 50, of Indianapolis, Indiana, died on Monday, January 20th at home on hospice. Chris was born on October 7, 1974 in Dearborn, Michigan, the son of Linda Susan Layne and Ed Wallace. He grew up in Kokomo, Indiana and graduated from Kokomo High School in 1993 and from William Carey College in Hattiesburg, Mississippi in 1997. Chris married Michelle (Payton) Wallace on December 22, 2007 and recently celebrated their 17th wedding anniversary. Together they have one child, Elijah, who is 15. He held on as long as he could for them.

Chris loved helping people having worked as a teacher and in rehab therapy in group homes and with individual adults with special needs. His final job was helping people find financial resources to pay for their medical bills.

He was a huge fan of all things sci-fi, comic books, video games, and enjoyed Legendary game nights. He was known for his sense of humor. Chris respected the line of social appropriateness. He enjoyed the whooshing sound it made as he blew past it.

Chris was a Colts fan since the Mayflower landed in 1984 and a fan of Indy Car since attending the first of over 25 races when he was 7. He loved musicals and sang every song he knew, remembering every word perfectly, though far less particular about the notes.

Chris enjoyed ancient history and theology and had started seminary before his cancer diagnosis in 2021. He had taken several graduate classes in

philosophy and theology and was hoping to become a chaplain. He had the privilege of participating in 2 archeological digs in Israel in 1996 at Tel Beth Shean and 1998 with his brother at Tel Rehov.

Chris was preceded in death by his father, Ed Wallace, and his grandparents, Mildred and Milford Layne and John and Dorothy Mae Wallace. He is survived by his wife, Michelle; son, Eli; mother, Linda; brother Rob (Cindy); and nephews, Daniel and Thomas.
