Dale Edward Roeschlein, 81, of Indianapolis, passed away September 22, 2015. He was born June 13, 1934 in Brazil, IN, to the late Walter H. and Adah Faith Burger Roeschlein. Dale was a 1952 graduate of Cory High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army, and married Betty Jean Lowe, June 14, 1964. Dale received his Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering from Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology in 1956, and was an electrical engineer for RCA and Public Service of Southern Indiana. He was an accomplished photographer and owner of Studio-D Photography for 30 years. During his career Dale achieved status as a Master Craftsman Photographer. Dale was a longtime member of Epworth United Methodist Church, the Professional Photographers of both Indiana and America, and the Daguerre Club.
