David "Dave" Keith Lowry, 59, of Indianapolis, passed away April 26, 2025. He was born August 22, 1965 in Indianapolis to the late Robert and Jane (Harmon) Lowry. David was a graduate of Shelbyville High School and attended Ball State University. He went to work for RCI and discovered a love of sales and customer service. David served as a Deputy Marshal in Trafalgar, Indiana, and became interested in law enforcement equipment and sales. He launched his own business, Enforcement Products, selling equipment such as radar guns, in-car camera systems, and body cameras to law enforcement. Most recently he was employed with Midwest Public Safety.

David loved people and never met a stranger. He loved being in sales and constantly sought ways to improve his craft. He was curious and an avid learner. David was also generous, kind, smart, caring, a great listener, and a wonderful mentor. He was probably the funniest person you would ever meet. David loved his friends, who he referred to as his "family." He loved going to Put-In-Bay and Key West and especially cherished the Christmas holidays he spent there with his sister, Susan. David enjoyed the Indianapolis Colts and Jimmy Buffett concerts. He loved Hibachi, cooking on his Blackstone, coffee, and key lime pie. David was obsessed with St. Elmo's shrimp cocktail sauce and would buy horseradish in bulk trying to perfect his own version of it. He even attended the International Horseradish Festival in Collinsville, Illinois. David also loved photography, magic, and "dad jokes." He enjoyed watching

his friends taste Malört for the first time. David created many traditions and happy memories for his friends and family.
