David T. O'Malia, 70, of Fishers, passed away May 24, 2022. He was born June 6, 1951 in Indianapolis to the late George "Joe" and Lois Walters O'Malia. David was a graduate of Cathedral High School Class of 1969. He received his bachelor's degree from Xavier University, and his Doctor of Jurisprudence from Indiana University. 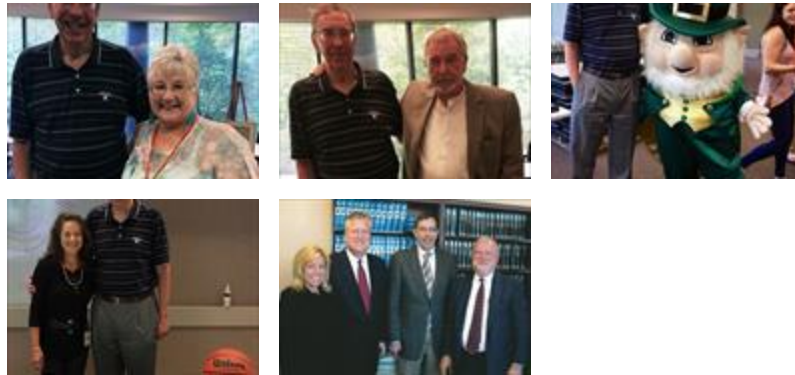
