74, of Indianapolis, passed away October 2, 2014. He was born October 5, 1939 to the late Joseph W. and Mary Esther Bowman Scott. David received his Bachelor's Degree in Radio & TV; majoring in Business, from Butler University. He began his career with Time Life working in news, programming and sales. David moved to Handley Miller Advertising where he was responsible for national, regional and local accounts, retiring after 20 years as Sr. Vice-President. He then went on to pursue a career with F.C. Tucker Co., Inc. in 1988 as Corporate Vice-President in charge of advertising, marketing, and public relations.

David was a Past President of the Advertising Club of Indianapolis where he received "Ad Man of the Year" and the "National Silver Medal" Award from the American Advertising Federation. He was Past President of the Lawrence Township Foundation; and past President board member of the St. Albans Baseball and Softball leagues, where he coached for 21 years. For his exemplary community commitment, he received the Mayor's community service award. He was involved and volunteered for Little Red Door Cancer Society and the American Red Cross of Greater Indianapolis.
