He went to elementary and middle school at School #77 and attended Irvington United Methodist Church, remaining an active member his entire life. In 1956, he graduated from Howe High School where he lettered in basketball, baseball, football, and track. He attended Hanover College where he played football and met his future wife, Catharine "Kitty" Strange. Dave began teaching after graduating in 1960. He and Kitty married on August 19, 1961. In 1962 Dave accepted a teaching job at Howe and the couple moved to Indianapolis. Dave taught economics and government and was the head football coach for eight years. He taught at Tech High School before retiring in 2001, ending 38 years of service to IPS. Throughout his life, Dave worked hard and expected the same from others. He was a great example of kindness, curiosity, and honesty. Faith was his guide; friends were his treasures; family was his pride and absolute joy. He is predeceased by his parents; his brothers; and granddaughter, Adelaide Johnson.
