Dean Albert Walters,

93, of Indianapolis, passed away September 6, 2014. He was born May 9, 1921, in Dow City, IA, to the late William Thomas and Amy Zelma Bonsall Walters.

Dean was a 1939 graduate of Dow City High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII in the Battle of the Bulge under Gen. George Patton and was awarded several medals including the Purple Heart. Dean married Eleanor Louise Fultz November 16, 1947, and was employed with Conrail as a clerk for over 37 years, retiring in 1984. He was a longtime member of Wallace Street Evangelical Church.

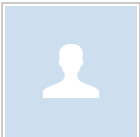

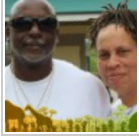
