Debbie Peters,

58, of Indianapolis, passed away September 24, 2014. She was born February 10, 1956 in St. Paul, MN, to the late Herluf and Bernice Soderlind. Debbie grew up in White Bear Lake, MN, and graduated from White Bear Lake High School in 1974. She earned a Bachelor's Degree from North Central University in Minneapolis, MN.

Debbie was the Secretary Treasurer and Director of Music for Global Training Ministries. As an accomplished concert pianist, she ministered in 43 nations around the world doing Christian missions with GTM.

Later in life she was an Executive Director for Tee-Shirts 4 Troops working tirelessly for active duty wounded warriors during the current conflict. The sites of their efforts included Bethesda Naval Medical Center, Walter Reed Army Hospital, Brooke Army Medical Center as well as Landstuhl Regional Medical Center in Germany.
