Debra “Debbie” Rose Schornhorst, age 54, of Indianapolis, IN, passed away Saturday, February 27, 2016 after a courageous battle with ALS (Lou Gehrig’s Disease). Debbie was born in Sellersburg, IN on November 25, 1961 to Vera Schornhorst and the late Rudolph “Rudy” Schornhorst.

As a 1979 graduate of Carmel High School, Debbie participated in the band, was a manager for the Lady Greyhound Volleyball team, and grew up as an active member of the Carmel Pup’s girl’s flag football team.
