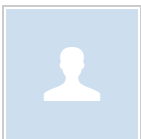

The choice was very simple, as my mom wanted to move closer to her one living sister and my aunt Titi Lola. Immediately following their move I followed. The most remarkable attribute that I can recall of Titi Lola is the resemblance between her and my mother “FIFA”The resemblance was so unique and detailed that I always said she was my second mom. In 1991, my wife Betsy, the kids and I followed our decision to be close to my mom and dad and my Titi Lola and Uncle Louie with the added bonus of my mom’s and Titi Lola’s brother Toyo who also lived close by..
