



Donald Keith Goodwin

September 3, 1928 - September 15, 2022

Donald Keith Goodwin, 94, of Indianapolis, passed away September 15, 2022. He was born September 3, 1928 in Lafayette, Indiana to the late Sheldon Goodwin and Helen Keen Goodwin. Donald graduated from Howe High School Class of 1946 and in 1950 he received a bachelor's degree in Forestry and Education from Purdue University. He married the love of his life, Marjorie "June" Kennedy and began building a beautiful family. They were married for 74 years. In 1951, Donald founded and operated Goodwin Tree Farm. He was Indiana's largest Christmas tree grower and helped organize the Indiana Christmas Tree Growers Association which presented the National tree to the White House in 1968 to President Johnson. Donald also planted several million trees across Indiana. Along with forestry and education, he was very proud to call himself an Eagle Scout for more than 80 years; he was a Firecrafter and a member of the Society of American Foresters. Visitation will be Sunday, September 18, 2022 from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel, 9606 East Washington St. Donald is survived by his wife of 74 years, June Goodwin; daughter, Cynthia "Kay" Price (Steve); sons, Father James Goodwin, and Steven Goodwin (Valerie); grandchildren, Jason Price (Tracy Tughan), Zachary Price (Rachel), Jacob Goodwin (Jena), Katelyn Porter (Jason), Brittany Goodwin (Jacob Wells); and three great grandchildren, Zoe Price, Jasper Price and Emery Price. Donald was preceded in death by his son, Terry Goodwin; and brother,

Keene Goodwin.
