Rev. Donald N. "Nick" Senior I, 78, of Trafalgar, Indiana, passed away April 10, 2022. He was born June 3, 1943 in Beech Grove to the late W. Lee and Janet L. Hatten Senior. Nick was a graduate of Southport High School. He married Karen Sue Dawson, August 26, 1961, and was a licensed minister for UPCI and owner/operator of Senior Enterprises for 40 years.

Nick was the founder and pastor of New Life Apostolic Church in Bean Blossom, Indiana. He also pastored Brookville United Pentecostal Church, Brookville, Indiana, Apostolic Revival Tabernacle, Columbus, Indiana, and founder of Living Word Apostolic Church, Aurora, Indiana.
