Don Willman, 80, of Fishers, Indiana passed away April 1, 2013. Don was born July 30, 1932, in Hartford City, IN, to the late George A. and Nellie Leach Willman. He graduated from Hartford City High School in 1950 and Indiana University in 1954, where he earned a business degree and rode in the first Little 500. Don also served his country in the U.S. Air Force as a Pilot from 1954-57. Don retired from GMAC Dealer Finance Services in 1992 after 35 years of service.
