She served as an elder, deacon and Sunday school teacher at her church, Irvington Presbyterian. Dori enjoyed her friends, family and grandchildren. Following a stroke in 2002, Dori was active as a Community Hospital East volunteer as a peer stroke visitor, which she enjoyed very much. She also participated in a post stroke rehab study through the University of Indianapolis. Dori is survived by her husband, Howard; 2 daughters, Beth Ann (Kerry) Calvert and Jennifer Brewster (Robert) Rosebrock; as well as 3 grandchildren; Corey Andrew Rosebrock, Kelli Michelle Rosebrock and Kristen Elise Calvert.
