



## Dorothy Mae Montgomery Smith

February 19, 1920 - July 16, 2017

Dorothy Mae Montgomery Smith, 97, of Indianapolis, passed away July 16, 2017 . She was born February 19, 1920 in Sabetha, Kansas to Lillian Mae (Church) and Charles E. Montgomery. Dorothy graduated from Sabetha High School in 1937 and from Kansas State University in 1942 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Dietetics and Institutional Management. She completed her Dietetics internship at the Indiana University Medical Center in 1943 and remained on staff for three years. She married William F. Smith in March 1943 and he preceded her in death, September 2004. She was also employed at Winona Hospital and as a Chief Dietician at Community Hospital East, retiring in 1985.

Dorothy was a member of Irvington Presbyterian Church and served as a deacon, Sunday school teacher, Circle leader, Parish leader, and was on the Board of the Woman's Association. She was a member of PEO Chapter V and Community Hospital Retirees.

She is survived by her sons, Jon C. Smith of Seattle, Washington and James M. Smith (Laura Dorsey) of Burlington, Kentucky; two grandchildren, Julian and Clair Smith of Seattle; brothers, Edwin Montgomery (Leota) and Donald Montgomery (Nancy); several nieces and nephews, all of Sabetha, Kansas. Her sister, Margaret Dillaplain of Omaha, Nebraska , preceded her in death in 2009.
