Dorothy B. Toth, 91 years young, passed away Saturday, May 23rd at Community East Hospital Hospice, surrounded by beloved family members. Dorothy was born September 7th, 1917 to Lloyd and Lois (Anglin) Bottorff in Plymouth, Indiana. Being raised in the depression years, Dorothy worked hard at her fathers bait & tackle business, and her grandparents farm.
