



Dr. Albert Bruce Stroud

June 9, 1924 - January 9, 2011

86, of Marco Island, FL, previously of Indianapolis, passed away January 9, 2011. He was born June 8, 1924 in Indianapolis to the late Samuel H. and Georgia B. Andersen Stroud. A lifelong resident of Indianapolis, Albert was a graduate of Warren Central High School and a 1948 graduate of Northern Illinois College of Optometry. He served his country in the U.S. Air Army Corps during WWII, and married Laura M. Hart August 31, 1946. Dr. Stroud was a 50 year member of the CIOA (Central Indiana Optometric Association), serving many of those years as the Secretary Treasurer. He was a member of the IOA, named optometrist of the Year, which is the IOA's highest award, bestowed upon the IOA member demonstrating most contributions to their profession and also service to the public and community at large. He was also a member of the American Academy of Optometry. Albert was a member of Sertoma International Castleton Club, where he received the Centurion Award for outstanding community and club service, the Irvington Masonic Lodge, now currently known as Prospect Lodge, the Scottish Rite, Kiwanis, student and later instructor in the Dale Carnegie program, a licensed private pilot, certified scuba diver, served on the Board of the Central Indiana YMCA, and in his spare time enjoyed fishing, hunting and jogging.
