Dr. Charles Edward Crawford, D.D.S., 82, of Indianapolis, passed away January 25, 2018. He was born October 11, 1935 to the late France and Mary Josephine Crawford. Charles graduated from Cathedral High School in 1953, received his Bachelors Degree from Marian University in 1960, and his Doctorate in Dentistry from Indiana University School of Dentistry in 1964.
