*My heartfelt condolences to his beautiful children. He loved you all more than he loved life itself. If any of you ever need anything, all you have to do is ask.*

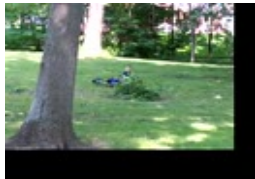
