E. Beatrice "Bea" Wagner, 98, of Indianapolis, passed away August 31, 2014. She was born June 6, 1916 in Perry Co., IN, to the late Arlie C. and Florence Miles Rickenbaugh. Bea was a 1934 graduate of Bristow High School, IN, and a 1937 graduate of the International Barber and Beauty College. She married Don C. Wagner December 25, 1938, and he preceded her in death March 29, 1999. Bea was the owner/operator of Bea's Beauty Shop for 20 years. She then worked in accounting for H & R Block Co. for nine years, retiring as manager of the Cumberland office.
