Edward M. Ed Ingersoll, 89, of Indianapolis, passed away October 27, 2011. He was born March 21, 1922, in Indianapolis to Homer M. and Bertha Dunbar Ingersoll. Ed was a 1940 graduate of Arsenal Technical High School. He married Anna E. Betty Lineback on December 31, 1941. Ed served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII, fighting at the Battle of the Bulge in the Ardennes Mountains.
