



## Eileen M. Hurley

November 3, 1924 - March 19, 2021

Eileen McGraw Hurley, 96, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 19, 2021 surrounded by her family. Born as the fifth of nine children to Mary Meyer McGraw and George A. McGraw in Marion, IN on November 3, 1924, Eileen spent most of her young life in Muncie where she was a member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church and a 1942 graduate of Muncie Central High School. It was after her graduation that she worked for the Moore-Hurley Clinic and later for Dr. Anson G. Hurley as an office manager.

In May of 1962, Eileen married Dr. John R. Hurley at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Muncie and subsequently moved to Daleville where Dr. Hurley had a medical practice. She and her husband were blessed with two sons over the ensuing years and she found her days filled with volunteering for a myriad of organizations and homemaking, with her sons being the center of her life.

After a lifetime spent between Muncie and Daleville, in 1996 Eileen moved to the Northside of Indianapolis to be closer to her children. Over the most recent 25 years, she found much joy working with St. Vincent DePaul and the Cathedral Soup Kitchen, as well as being an enthusiastic participant at daily mass at Holy Spirit at Geist Catholic Church. It was with her involvement at Holy Spirit Geist that she formed so many wonderful relationships that endured until she was called to her eternal home. Her love and gratitude for her church community and her wonderful neighbors were an immeasurable blessing.
