Elsie "Marie" Pollard,

Advanced Senior Mother Elsie Marie Pollard was born April 5, 1941, in Richmond, Kentucky to the late Deacon Buddie B. Farris Sr. and Senior Mother Nannette Martin Farris Huguely. She was the oldest of seven children. Although she lost her natural father at a young age, she was blessed, for a period of time, to have a wonderful stepfather, the late Sr. Deacon Curtis D. Huguely.

Advanced Senior Mother Marie Pollard attended Richmond Elementary School and Madison Senior High School. She received her teaching degree in Education from Eastern Kentucky University in 1965. Advanced Senior Mother Marie Pollard went on to teach in the Indianapolis Public School system for 39 years during which time she obtained her master's degree from Ball State University.

Born a member of The Supreme Council of the House of Jacob, Advance Senior Mother Marie attended church services regularly. While attending one of the many church convocations, she befriended Sister Virginia Pollard. Through this friendship, she met and married her best friend Advanced Presiding Elder James W. Pollard on August 15, 1965. From this union came one daughter, Elderess Hannah Fantroy of Dallas, Texas.

Advance Senior Mother Marie was elevated to the Ministry at a young age. She was licensed as a Junior Minister on October 12, 1967, in Pontiac, MI; ordained on July 13, 1969, in Loveland, OH; consecrated to the Motherhood

on Aug 8, 1971, in Chicago, IL; elevated to Senior Mother on September 10, 1972, in Pontiac, MI; and elevated to the rank of Advanced Senior Mother on Aug 23, 1981, in Bethlehem Township, OH.

The Supreme Council of the House of Jacob wasn't just part of Advanced Senior Mother Marie's life, IT WAS HER LIFE! And what a life it was attending the various church functions throughout the coast of Israel such as revivals, district meetings, the Wild Game & Seafood Dinners & Annual Regional Convocations in Bethlehem Township, Ohio; Loretto, Maryland, Seffner, Florida & Casa Grande, Arizona. Advanced Senior Mother Marie not only loved the Lord, but she loved His people! She found fulfillment in serving and hosting Father W. B. Israel, S.O.T. and Father J. Daniel Israel, J.O.G. and their families as well as many others over the years in her home. When she was able to cook and feed the people of God, you found her doing so with much joy! She loved doing for the people of God and was often found cooking and baking cakes for whatever celebration or church event taking place. Father J. Daniel Israel, J.O.G. once said, "You Can't Stop Her!" Advanced Senior Mother Marie didn't stop. She held several positions in the church auxiliaries; her most recent and lifetime position was the Church & Financial Secretary of the Central Banking System. Many who knew her well know that Advanced Senior Mother Marie was a very fiery preacher that her favorite song was, "I Know There Is A God" written by the Honorary First Lady, Superior Mother Melita Collins.

Many lives were touched both naturally and spiritually by Advanced Senior Mother Marie; and because of God's love that she exhibited to many, they can say it changed their lives. She never failed to give encouraging words or sound advice to others and help those in need. She continually reminded everyone to keep our Father first and trust in Him that He'll bring us through. Advanced Senior Mother Elsie Marie Pollard gave up the Ghost, in her home, on July 2, 2022 in Indianapolis, Indiana. She is preceded in death by her parents, Deacon Buddie Farris Sr & Sr. Mother Nannette Martin Farris Huguely; two brothers, Elder Hosea Farris and Brother Buddie Farris Jr.; two

sisters, Advanced Senior Mother Dorothy Arthur and Elderess Esther Farris; and one nephew, Brother Walter Arthur.

She leaves to cherish her memory, her husband of nearly 57 years, Advanced Presiding Elder James W.
