Emma Grace Lane, Of Indianapolis, Indiana passed into the presence of the Lord on Tuesday, June 26th, 2012, at the age of 84. Services will be at 11:00 a.m., Saturday at the Shirley Brothers Castleton Chapel, 9900 Allisonville Road, with visitation from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Friday, as well as one hour prior to services on Saturday. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery, 9350 E. Washington St. Mrs. Lane, who went by her middle name Grace, was the beloved wife of the late Donald L. Lane (1923-1997, who served in the Coast Guard in World War II and was a long-time employee of General Motors, retiring in 1982). Grace and Don raised three sons. Among the many things she did for her sons, Grace was the score-keeper for their little league teams, and eventually became the head score-keeper for the local league. It was an item of humor to her sons that their Mother taught the formal details of the little league score-keeping to many baseball- For several years Grace was a volunteer nurse-aid. She was involved in church all her life, most recently as a member of East 91st Street Christian Church, where she was an active volunteer. In recent years, Grace was the particular beneficiary of the kind and good friendship of Mr. Donald Horock, and of her neighbor Mrs. Darlene Freeman. Mrs. Lane is survived by three sons: James Robert Lane, Daniel Clifford (Luanne) Lane, and Jack LeRoy (Amy) Lane; brother John (Betty) Wiese, sister Lena Mae Cunningham; four grandchildren and two great-grandsons.
