



## Ernest Richard "Bud" Anderson

February 19, 1922 - October 13, 2007

Ernest R. ♦Bud♦ Anderson, Age 85, passed away October 13, 2007 at Claremont Retirement Village in Columbus, Ohio. He joins Helen, his wife of 54 years, who died in 2002. Living all but the last year and a half of his life in Indianapolis, Bud was a United States Marine Corps World War II veteran and a retired industrial engineer, working many years for Ransburg Corporation and Diamond Chain. After his retirement, he and Helen owned and operated Sweeping Contractors. Bud was past Commander of Hoosier Power Squadron, a member of VFW Post 2366, an avid sportsman, and skilled craftsman.
