She loved to spend time with her family and friends, sewing, quilting, crocheting, cooking, and spending time at church.

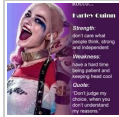
Final arrangements and care are being entrusted to Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel. A celebration of life ceremony will be held at a later date.
