



## Francis Joseph "Joe" Baumann

Francis Joseph "Joe" Baumann, 83, of Indianapolis, passed away September 19, 2022 at St. Francis Hospital, Indianapolis. He was born July 28, 1939 to William and Lillian (Hazeldence) Baumann. Joe grew up in Indianapolis and graduated from Sacred Heart High School in 1957. At the age of nine Joe started working part-time at Rush Box Company which he purchased in January 1960. He owned Rush Box Company until 1982. Joe also worked for the U.S. Post Office from June 1958 to June 1960, and for the Defense Finance and Accounting Service from 1990, retiring in August 2012. He was a volunteer at St. Francis Hospital from 1982 until 1990. Joe enjoyed water skiing and hang gliding. After retiring, he enjoyed traveling to Florida with his wife, Lynn.
